#### **OUR GOAL**

1000 New Congregations within the next five years.

- 2016 Approx. 250 new congregations at a cost of \$1,000,000.
- To date in 2017 we have processed and/or are processing 130 new congregations.
- One Example of a unique plant: Assisting the Ontario Conference with the Toronto Church for the Blind.





## **EVANGELISM**

- \$14.7 million budget investment.
- Thousands of campaigns conducted throughout the NAD in 2016/17
- Evangelist Ron Smith, Alex Bryant, Jose Cortes Jr. "Caravan" (305 baptisms).

# **COMPASSION 10 Million**

- Churches across the NAD involved in implementing the ministry of compassion. One example: Church in the Valley
- Houston and Florida Hurricanes. Expenditures of \$1,000,000. NAD, Unions and Conferences working together. 'The World Harvest Outreach Center. S.D.A. Church in South Houston - Major Distribution Center.



# CENTERS OF INFLUENCE

- GOAL: 50 Centers of Influence by 2021 in collaboration with GC, Unions and Conferences.
- The Urban Center of Influence in Minneapolis, Minnesota ministers to the large Somali refugee community.
- Since August we have approved funding for 3 Life-Hope Centers.



#### **EDUCATION**

Our Number #1 soul-building and soul-winning outreach in the North American Division is our system of education

- K-12 System that stretches from Bermuda through Guam/Micronesia. \$24,000,000 annual appropriation
