Connected to His Voice

"The Holy Spirit works when we are calling people into an abiding relationship with Jesus Christ. Preachers, and the church, will fail humanity. We need to be sure that [we help connect] people to the clear voice of the Holy Spirit in their lives — that is the only voice that will never fail them. So the first thing you've got to do ... is ask God to make sure you're connecting them with His voice, *not* your voice, *not* your strategy, *not* your plan, *not* your answer. "
