


#### **North American Division Membership -- 2011-2016**








#### **Union Transfers 2011-2015**




## Rates of Net Growth by Union



## Total Membership 1965 vs. Total Membership 2016






## Membership per Conference (10,000-15,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)








# Membership per Conference (15,000-20,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)












# Membership per Conference (50,000-55,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)




# Membership per Conference (55,000-60,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)





# Membership per Conference (60,000-65,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)







## Membership per Conference (65,000-70,000 Members as of 2nd Quarter 2017)








## Membership by Conference As of 2<sup>nd</sup> Quarter 2017






## Christians are the largest religious group in 2015

#### Number of people in 2015, in billions






